

## 9. Transportation

City Chucheon is locating 80km away from Seoul to North-East. It takes 2:30hrs from Incheon International Airport by bus, and 1:30hrs from Seoul Cheongyangni station by train. Organizers will provide free pick-up service from Incheon International Airport to the official hotel, Gangchon Youth Hostel, and shuttle bus runs between the official hotel to venue, 20 minutes, during competition.
